



Eaton Square Upper School, Mayfair – Admissions Process

We operate two systems of admissions procedure:

Standard Admissions: Interviews and assessments are done from October to January. Offers are made in February, and the closing date for acceptances is in March. This procedure might suit you best if you are still undecided about where you would like to send your child to school.

Fast Track Admissions: If you are confident that Eaton Square Mayfair is the right school for your child, then the fast track procedure may enable you to conclude the process within a few weeks of registration, with an unconditional offer. Standard Admissions

By Friday 18th November 2016

Registration forms should be completed together with a passport sized photograph, a copy of the candidate's birth certificate or passport, and a cheque or bank transfer for £150 to cover the registration fee.

October 2016 – January 2017

Candidates applying for places in Years 7 & 8 will complete the online ISEB Pre-Test, to be taken at their current school. If this is not possible, the candidate may be able to sit this test at Eaton Square School.

Candidates applying for places in Year 9 will sit written papers in Mathematics and English on **Friday 27th January 2017**. These will be our own papers but based on the 13+ Common Entrance syllabus.

Interviews will also be arranged at this time. These may take place before or after the ISEB Pre-Test, and will occur irrespective of the results of the test.

We will also ask for a confidential reference from the Head of the pupil's current school, together with their latest School Report.

Friday 10th February 2017

Offers will be sent out to parents by first class post and email.

Monday 6th March 2017

Acceptances to offers must be received by this deadline, together with a deposit of £4,000. There is an additional overseas deposit if one or more of the persons who are jointly responsible for paying the fees is resident outside the United Kingdom.

June 2017

We will send out an information pack during the summer term to pupils who have taken up a place for the following September.
