Rules and Regulations

THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY AT ALL TIMES

Garden entry keys shall not be loaned to any person who does not legally enjoy the right to enter the gardens

Please ensure the gates are closed on entering and leaving the gardens.

Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult whilst in the garden

Parties arranged with the prior agreement of Grosvenor and the Garden Committee are allowed.

The following activities are not Permitted

- Ball Games
- No wheeled vehicles (other than prams and wheel chairs) are allowed in the garden. The Estate's Gardener has authority to stop the riding of any wheeled vehicle if, in his sole opinion, a nuisance is being caused.
- Fireworks are forbidden and any noisy or unruly conduct will not be permitted
- Any other activity that may spoil the enjoyment of the garden by another garden user.
- The flowers must not be picked nor the trees, shrubs, plants or turf in any way injured nor the flowerbeds or borders trampled upon.

Dogs are only allowed in the smaller of the two gardens

- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times without exception.
- Dog Fouling – Please pick up after your dog

Failure to comply with the Garden Rules may result in your ability to use the gardens being withdrawn.

These gardens are the property of The Grosvenor Estate and are managed jointly with the Chester Square Garden Committee for the benefit of the of Chester Square residents.

Grosvenor wardens, gardeners, caretakers and members of the garden committee are authorised to take the necessary steps to ensure that these regulations are enforced.
